EUREGIO MOBILITY GRANT - Call for admission to the workshop “ViC-CH Visual Culture and Cultural Heritage”

Trento, Dpt. of Sociology and Social Research, January 28th - February 1st, 2019

ViC-CH is a project of the **University of Trento (Dept. of Civil Environmental and Mechanical Engineering DICAM)** and the **Free University of Bozen-Bolzano (Faculty of Education)** funded for the 2018-19 academic year by the “Euregio Mobility Fund”.

The Tyrol-South Tyrol-Trentino Europaregion offers 30 grants within the mobility project “**ViC-CH Visual Culture and Cultural Heritage**” that will take place in Trento at the Department of Sociology and Social Research on January 28th - February 1st, 2019. The grant allows the student to attend an **intensive 5 days workshop** devoted to image processing, drawing techniques and visual communication through free and open source software, for the knowledge and design of cultural heritage by means of graphic sciences, multimedia representation and digital environments.

Eligible students

Students enrolled at the **University of Trento** and the **Free University of Bozen-Bolzano** attending a Bachelor’s Degree, a Master’s Degree or a Doctoral Programme.

Number of available places:

15 places for students of UniTrento,

15 places for students of unibz.

The grant will include:

- **for UniTrento students**
each grant will cover costs for lunch and dinner;
- **for unibz students**
each grant will cover travel costs (public transport only, tickets purchased by the Home University) and accommodation costs (board included, costs covered directly by the Home University) for the whole duration of the workshop.

A student applying for an EUREGIO mobility grant is required to send the following **documents**:

- a **CV** (European format) and the permit of stay or passport (for non-UE citizens only);
- a one-page **motivation letter** (English and mother language) explaining how the topics of the workshop are related to his/her study plan or interests;
- a copy of the academic **transcript** with examination grades.

The **minimum requirement** for the student is the availability of a medium performance laptop.

The grants will be assigned on the basis of the following **criteria**:

- the relevance of the current and future **applicant's activities** within the topics covered by the workshop (30%);
- the **average grade** of the exams and number of credits obtained within 30/09/2018 (50%);
- other achievements (awards, publications, etc., 20%).

Students will be admitted according to the **ranking list** that will be available **within January 7, 2019**.

Admitted students will be contacted by Email and they will be requested to accept the place within the deadline stated in the mail.

In case of withdrawals of admitted students, other candidates can be admitted according to the ranking list order.

ViC-CH is part of the wide project "**The brand of memory**", launched by the University of Trento on the occasion of **2018 Year of European Cultural Heritage** and focused on the study and conservation of material culture of a people.
