The annual Conference on Rhetoric – GTR22 Trento Days on Rhetoric - will be held on May 23-24, 2022 at the University of Trento, Faculty of Law, Italy.

The 2022 meeting will address a range of scientific, social, policy issues around the deliberative communication and the role of rhetoric. Panels will discuss about communicating as a social practice, offering some explanations on how personal involvement is achieved, how it is possible to combine freedom and responsibility in public communication, why rhetoric is necessary and what is its relationship with argumentative practice.

The abstract must be written in English and must not exceed 500 words in length, including the author's information (name, surname, title and affiliation).

The abstract will be evaluated in relation to its congruence with respect to the topics of the Conference and the originality of the contents.
