

BIOGRAPHY

David Hollander is Assistant Dean of Real World and Clinical Professor with the Preston Robert Tisch Institute for Global Sport at New York University (NYU). He is the recipient of NYU's highest faculty honor, 2019 NYU Distinguished Teaching Award, among other numerous teaching and service awards.

Author of How Basketball Can Save the World: 13 Guiding Principles for Reimaging What's Possible (Harmony/Penguin Random House 2023), based on his popular course of the same name at NYU.

Hollander is credited for swaying the Pope to recognize a Patron Saint of Basketball and for moving the United Nations to establish World Basketball Day. He sits on a number of advisory boards including for espnW, The Earl Monroe New

Renaissance Basketball School, NYU Entrepreneurial Institute, and Our Saviour Lutheran School.

Hollander holds his high school record for most technical fouls in a season and a career.
